**BUILDING** is in Connolly resident Raymond Kershaw's blood, but the road to becoming one of WA's youngest licensed builders has not been easy. He finished high school and followed his dad into the trade as a carpenter's apprentice.

While working full-time he earned a Diploma in Building and Construction at night school, a course that took seven years to complete and qualified him for a licence.
